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Project Description

Sleep-like states have been described in multiple insect systems, where these have been linked to immune functionality, stress tolerance, and reproductive aspects, but little is known about sleep-like states in blood feeding insects. In this project, we will characterize this overlooked aspect of insect biology through combined behavioral and physiological studies, and follow this with sleep manipulation studies to determine impact of sleep deprivation on reproduction and host preferences. The information generated from this research will be critical to understand how periods of sleep-like states impact blood feeding insect biology, potentially revealing targets of opportunity for control.
